December 1, 1980 was the birth of CCBC, when the only black school teacher (Paul Dow) in the

Boonville school system was on the verge of losing his job because of two failed tax increases. Larry Rowles, and other black residents went door to door in support of Paul Dow to help protect his job. After winning their first skirmish, Rowles and several other residents joined forces and formed the Concerned Citizens for the Black Community, now known as the Concerned Citizens for a Better Community.

For the past 35 years, CCBC, Inc. has had more triumphs than sorrows. CCBC, Inc. has continued to provide additional cultural, educational, entrepreneurial, and recreational opportunities in the Cooper County and surrounding areas.
